DAY 1: Arrival at the airport

DAY 2-3: Arusha to Sinya (Western Kilimanjaro)

After a delicious breakfast, your private safari guide will pick you up and you'll journey to one of Tanzania's most untouched treasures **Sinya**, located in the remote wilderness of **Western Kilimanjaro**.

This vast, private concession spans over **600 square kilometers** and shares its northern border with **Kenya's Amboseli National Park**. As you arrive, you'll be welcomed by **breathtaking views of Mount Kilimanjaro**, Mount Meru, and the ancient volcanic peaks of Ol Doinyo Longido and Ol Doinyo Orok. This is where **adventure meets authenticity**.

Sinya is not just about wildlife it's also about **people**, **tradition**, **and untouched beauty**. Scattered across this remote land are a few Maasai "bomas" (traditional homesteads), home to one of the **most authentic Maasai communities** in Tanzania. Here, the Maasai live much as they have for centuries untouched by mass tourism, proudly wearing their traditional attire and following ancient customs.

DAY 4: West Kilimanjaro to Tarangire National Park

After a nourishing breakfast in the peaceful wilderness of Western Kilimanjaro, your private safari guide will pick you up and begin your journey to **Tarangire National Park**, a true hidden gem on the northern safari circuit.

Named after the life-giving **Tarangire River**, this park becomes a vital refuge for wildlife during the dry season earning it the nickname "The River of Warthogs". The landscape is surprisingly diverse, with towering **baobabs**, thick **acacia woodlands**, **elephant grass**, and lush **groundwater forests**.

Tarangire is famed for its **large herds of elephants**, often seen gathering along the riverbanks a captivating sight for any wildlife enthusiast. You might also spot **giraffes**, **bushbucks**, **hartebeests**, and a wide variety of predators such as **lions and leopards**, stealthily roaming the savannah. Bird

lovers are in for a special treat Tarangire boasts the highest number of breeding bird species in the world.

After an exhilarating game drive and soaking in the raw beauty of the park, you'll head to your carefully selected accommodation for **dinner and a peaceful overnight stay** surrounded by the sounds of the wild.

DAY 5: Lake Manyara National Park.

After breakfast, you will drive to Lake Manyara National Park.



This is a relatively small but diverse park, 120km west of Arusha. The park's namesake is a shallow, salt lake. It covers a large area of the park, flooding

and drying with the seasons and is home to thousands of flamingos and over 500 other bird species. On your exploration of the park you will see monkeys, giraffe, zebra, wildebeest, buffalo, elephant and with some luck, lions lounging in the trees. The park is known for its diverse landscapes; not only open grassy plains, but also primate-filled woodlands and baobab dotted cliffs.

After lunch and extensive game drive you will drive to your accommodation for dinner & overnight.

DAY 6: Serengeti National Park.

After breakfast, you will continue towards the fertile highlands where wheat and corn are grown by the Iraqw people



. Along the way we'll pass through the mist-shrouded rainforests of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area where you might be lucky enough to see baboons, or even leopards and elephants in the dense undergrowth. Passing through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, you will be able to see the breath-taking Ngorongoro Crater before traveling onwards to the Serengeti National Park, which you will reach by midday. The Serengeti National Park is the largest park in Tanzania with diverse landscapes and habitats, such as grassy plains, swamps, lakes, savannah and mountains. After an extensive game drive, you will drive to your accommodation where you will enjoy dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 7: Serengeti National Park.

You will spend the whole day exploring the park, its animals and incredible landscapes. The Serengeti is the habitat for an abundance of wildlife, such as impalas, buffalo, crocodiles and hippos, but is more well-known for its great migrating herds of zebras and wildebeest. The Seronera Valley offers lots of wildlife throughout the year including carnivores like hyenas, Lions, leopards and cheetah can often be found on and around these large rocky outcrops, as they offer a great vantage point to look over the plains in search of any prey, as well as ungulates including buffaloes, giraffes, hippopotami, impalas, topi, warthogs and zebras. You will have dinner and overnight at out careful chosen tented camp.

DAY 8: Serengeti to Ngorongoro Crater.

Early morning after breakfast, we continue with our en-route drive inside the Serengeti National Park before we depart to Ngorongoro crater. When you first see Ngorongoro Crater, it looks like a forgotten world. Concealed by the steep volcanic walls is a pristine wilderness including sweeping savannah, pockets of acacia woodland and glistening lakes and swamps. The Crater was created when a large volcano exploded and collapsed in on itself two to three million years ago. It is famous for both its geological delights and for being a natural reserve which is home to some of the densest large mammal populations in the whole of the African continent. The drive down the into the Crater is an adventure in itself and when you reach the Crater floor, you quickly find yourself amongst large numbers of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, and more than 500 bird species. The Crater provides you with the best chance of seeing the endangered black rhino, which can sometimes be spotted in the open grasslands.

After Lunch and an extensive game drive inside the crater, we head for our luxury partner lodges in Karatu for dinner and overnight.
